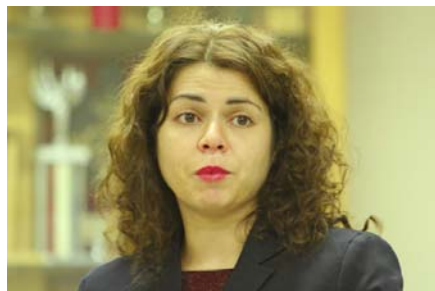

## Paul Jan Zdunek – Modesto Symphony



~by John Freeland - The Modesto Symphony is 75 years old, and is going through some transitions. President and CEO Paul Jan Zdunek shared with us some of the changes facing the Symphony. It will perform at the Gallo Center for the Arts once the Center opens. It is also looking for a new conductor, as Darryl One is leaving next spring. The Symphony will also be managing the State Theater once the current renovations at the State are finished. Paul told us that he came to speak to

us mostly to share an appreciation of classical music and to encourage us to give the Symphony a try. He says that music appreciation is a journey, and each of us is at a different point on the spectrum of that journey. He compared it to one’s experience with drinking wine. The more you experience wine tasting, the better you recognize the subtleties between wines, and the better you appreciate a fine bottle of wine. The same is true with classical music. It takes a sampling of music over time to grow on this spectrum of appreciation. The Symphony encourages student participation through the Student Sound Check Card. For \$25, students have access to 16 classical concerts. Through the Arts Access Fund, the Symphony also assists seniors and families who otherwise would not be able to attend.
