Heidi Santino, Stanislaus County Health Services Agency Foundation Chairman, told us about the health services offered by Stanislaus County to all citizens. There is an impressive array of programs and health coverage for children and families, including indigent (6000 patients per year) and low-income citizens. The services are badly needed here, as the county is 3<sup>rd</sup> in the state for coronary heart disease and white infant mortality. Much of the problem is not the lack of services, but the fact that people don't take advantage of them. A public health – education outreach program is in place to try to combat this. There is evidence that the drug abuse problems in the county contribute to the health issues as well as to the lack of education about the available programs. This seems to be supported by our rank of 7<sup>th</sup> in the state for drug-related deaths.



The Stanislaus County Health Services Agency Foundation was formed in 1982 as a non-profit 501 (c) (3) organization to support the work of Scenic Hospital. Scenic Hospital was the county hospital for Stanislaus County until 1997, but the work of the Foundation continues in supporting the Stanislaus County Health Services Agency (HSA).

The Stanislaus County HSA has provided healthcare to the residents of Stanislaus County since 1891. The HSA operates under the leadership of the elected, five-member Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors. Originally located in a two-story, Victorian wooden building called the Alms House, the Agency has grown into an outpatient and public health system serving nearly 500,000 patients and clients each year. At present, the HSA provides service through: outpatient medical offices in nine locations throughout the county; a mobile medical office called the MOMobile; the Public Health Department; Women's, Infant's and Children's Program (WIC); Stanislaus Family Practice Residency Program, Indigent Health Care Program, health promotion and wellness programs and a Medi-Cal insurance product operated in partnership with Blue Cross of California. The main campus for the HSA is located at 830 Scenic Drive in Modesto.
