~by John Freeland - One thing we all see happening to our community is growth. Pastor Mike Sudfeld of Modesto Christian School tells us that MCS has a vision of its future that incorporates growth with quality education in a Christian environment. This vision has a purpose: to position MCS so that it remains relevant for future generations. Part of the vision is to create the premier college preparatory high school in the Central Valley. The other part of the vision is to bring the pre-school and elementary school to the same physical location as the high school and junior high campus.

This vision is taking shape in the Above and Beyond Campaign, a 24 million dollar project for upgrading and expansion. In the first phase half of that money will be invested in a new 74,000 square foot building that will house the middle school. The elementary school will then move into the former middle school facility. This could be completed as early as one year from now. The second phase will involve construction of a stadium, turf fields, a pool, weight room and an all weather track. Part of this phase is already underway with construction of four softball diamonds. Another part of phase two is investment of five million dollars in teacher endowments and student scholarships.
