An effective after-school program is one of the ways to do that. One of the many socio-economic benefits the program has is deterring the juvenile crime that statistics show happens most between 3 and 6 pm. After school programs afford children a chance to have social interaction, homework help, tutoring, and other benefits in a safe and productive environment. The students are provided with a nutritious snack, one hour of academics, and a choice of arts and crafts, sports, games, or movies.



Tommy Joyce wants to upgrade the Christmas decorations in downtown Salida and put new banners on the light posts. He's hoping Salida Rotary will help.

The cost is based on the ability to pay and even those who can only pay \$20, about the cost of the snacks. Parents benefit also. Not only do they save money on day care, tutoring, and recreation costs, but they can be more productive at work knowing that their children are being productively and creatively occupied at school. In addition, the program employs nearly 200 people in our district. However, help is needed from the community to offer programs ranging from martial arts to computer programs.

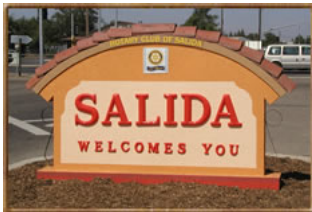
