by John Freeland - The Central Valley means agriculture. High school students have an avenue for hands-on learning about agriculture and ecosystems through the Center for Land-Based Learning. Children in the program may mentor with local farmers and ranchers, or assist governmental agencies. Children learn many aspects of agriculture and the environment, including farming, nutrition, and how we interface with our environment. Students develop personal strengths such as leadership, tolerance, and cooperation. The program, which operates from San Diego to Chico, includes children of diverse backgrounds, and includes at-risk children. Part of the program includes activities for the children to give back to their communities, such as through planting projects.

The FARMS Leadership Program teaches children environmentally sound agricultural practices that preserve land and resources for future generations. It

places students in agricultural settings in their communities where they can see the application of basic environmental and agricultural sciences. Another aspect of the program is SLEWS - Student and Landowner Education and Watershed Stewardship Program. This program focuses on bio-diversity and habitat restoration. Children learn about the environment often not far from their homes, learn what species might be endangered, and learn ways to improve the environment such as through habitat restoration.

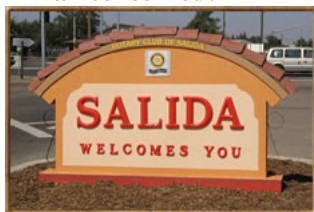
