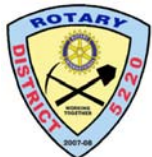

Regardless of the outcome of the petition, buses will be rolling down Stoddard Road to our new high school in August 2010! ~by John Freeland - After years of planning and delays, construction of Gregori High School has begun. It's only a beginning – rough grading and site work – but things are moving forward. Gregori should be completed by 2010. The school will open with freshmen and sophomores, many drawn from Salida Middle School. A drive is on to see that Gregori High School has a Salida address, including the ZIP code 95368. Dana McGarry from Modesto City Schools told us a petition has been filed with the U.S. Postal Service to have the area surrounding future Gregori High School change its postal address from Modesto to Salida. The petition has the support of the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors, the Stanislaus County Office of Education, and the Salida Union School District. The change would impact residences and businesses west of Dale Road, north of Kiernan, and south of Ladd. Modesto

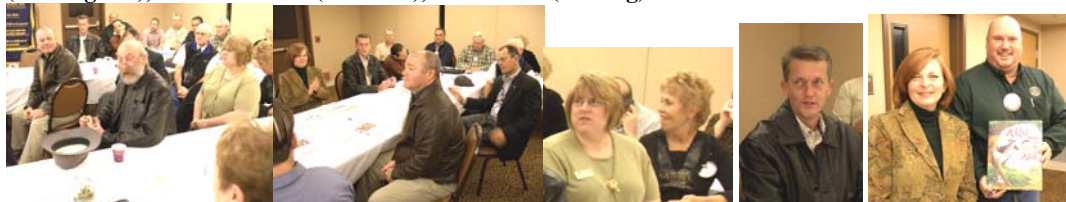
