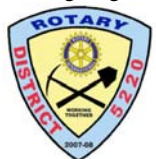

Today we heard from two World War II veterans and others who told us where they were on December 7, 1941 – the day the Japanese bombed Pearl Harbor.

Joel Ivie first heard the news on the radio getting ready to go to work in his first year of teaching. Roy Jones was working on a ranch and took a coffee break, turned on the radio and heard. Helen Buffington was at UCD and had gone with friends on a picnic when other friends came to find them and give them the news. Don Singer was working on Pacific Avenue in Stockton when the police came by to tell his Navy friends that they needed to report back to Mare Island.

Then we heard from Leroy Streeter:

He was on the USS California, stationed in Pearl Harbor. He heard the explosions and the call to go to their fighting stations. They were hit by torpedoes and were going down. They counter-flooded the starboard side and the started to abandon ship. When he got to shore a “Marine” made him go back to fight the fire. Instead, he ended up helping to save his buddy who was trapped in the battery room, for which he got a medal.

Don Singer joined the Marines the Monday after December 7, 1941. He served in the Pacific Theater, including Iwo Jima, where he was in the tank corps. He said he was down the beach when the famous “flag holding” was performed.

There were other stories and memories from these three great men. We sang patriotic songs as a tribute to them and the many other men who risked their lives for our freedom.
