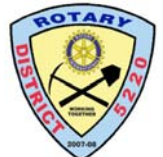

Karen Williams of the Stanislaus Literacy Center spoke to us on Friday. Karen, who has been with the center for 12 years, explained the beginnings of the Center. A local company, Tri-Valley Growers, bought new forklifts in the early 90's that were driven using computer panels. It was then that they discovered that some of the workers could not read. In an effort to solve this problem, the Stanislaus Literacy began. The problem has not gone away, however. The U.S. Department of Education states that of U.S. English-speaking adults, 42% are in the two lower levels of literacy. Of these, there are 100,000 adults in Stanislaus County that can not read.

A client of the center spoke to us of her experience. Paulina Rios was very grateful for the center and for the new start it gave her. She is now able to help her son with his homework and read menus and road signs.

Karen gave us several ways we could help. We can become tutors, make contributions, and attend fundraisers.

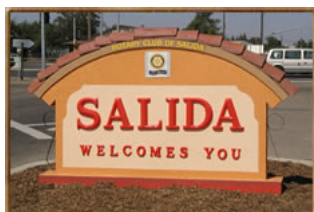
