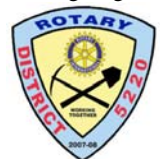

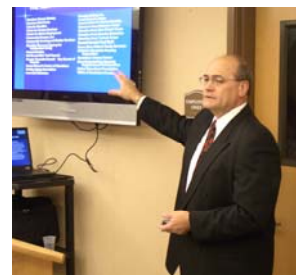

STEVE SMITH - UNITED WAY & 2-1-1



Steve Smith, our presenter on Friday, actually lives right here in Salida.

The United Way of Stanislaus County serves the needs of about 170,000 county residents by providing funding for 28 non-profit organizations in our community. The funding campaign for 2007-2008 is \$3,300,000. Several local businesses provide support on a yearly basis, as do thousands of individuals. Steve Smith, Director of Marketing for the United Way, says that much of that goal would be met if people who currently don't contribute would step up to the plate and give a dollar a week. Steve says that 99% of every dollar contributed stays in our community. Moreover, only 13% is spent on overhead, which is low compared to other non-profits. United Way of Stanislaus is the sponsor of 2-1-1, a three digit telephone number, manned 24 hours a day, that provides the caller with resource information. For instance, a caller can obtain locations for temporary shelter, food, transportation, health care, and mental health care and counseling, just to name a few. It is a lifeline for people who might otherwise not know where to turn. For more information regarding 2-1-1, check out their website at www.uwaystan.org, and click on the 2-1-1 link.
