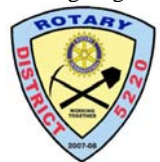

## KHUNTI SECONDARY SCHOOL



Al Neep tells us of his life in India

~by John Freeland - Al Neep is a former law enforcement officer from our community. Al and his wife had a calling for missionary work. So, they left the comfort of Stanislaus County, and now help run the Khunti SDA Senior Secondary School in Khunti, India. Khunti is located in a agricultural and jungle area, sixty miles from Calcutta.

Eighty-three percent of India's 1.2 billion people live on less than \$2 a day. Extreme poverty means most of the children of Khunti have little hope for the future. As Al explained, only children who learn English have a chance to break out of the cycle of poverty that permeates Indian society. Khunti's SDA Senior Secondary School provides education and hope to 1,400 children. 800 of those children board at the school, and half of those borders are orphans.

The Khunti SDA Senior Secondary School is operated by the Seventh Day Adventist Church. The Seventh Day Adventist Church operates several schools throughout India, providing education and hope to thousands of children.
