Formed over thirty years ago, the foundation now serves nearly fifty thousand people each year in Stanislaus County and its surrounding communities.

The foundation offers education in several areas, including:

- Childbirth and family education;
- Prevention education and management services for diabetes;
- Medical Outreach Mobile (MOM) provides education and health care for pregnant women;
- Safety Training, including CPR and First Aid Training;
- Dental Health Nutrition;
- HIV and AIDS awareness;
- Kids Works Puppet Theater.

Jeanie Miller from the foundation tells us that the Kids Works Project provides health and safety information to young children through puppets. The presentations are designed to help children understand, and diffuse myths about persons with disabilities, social issues, and individual differences. Peggy Bowen and Lisa Savelli, the two puppeteers for Kids Works, entertained us with a puppet show on child abuse. As they explained, the shows are designed to be entertaining for the children, yet educate them on important topics.
