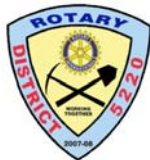

## Charles Grom, Vocational



Our vocational presentation today was Lieutenant Charles Grom, the Northwest Area Commander for the Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department. Charles is a native Modestian who eventually made his way back here to serve the community of his birth. After being raised by what he described as "normal" parents and graduating from Grace Davis High School, Charles took business courses and then TV and film at MJC. He then left for San Diego State. He assured us he was not there for the parties! The criminology classes there caught his interest. He came back here and attended the local police academy, where he paid his way by working nights at Juvenile Hall.

Charles joined the Sheriff's department in 1989 and had various jobs in the department including investigations and crimes against children. After going back to the streets for a while, he came back to supervise crimes against children, became a lieutenant, and is now the Area Commander.

When asked what he would recommend for someone who might want to follow in his footsteps, Charles said education is vital, especially for the critical thinking skills you learn.
