PDG Mark Oliver presents a pin to George Halpin, who just became our newest Paul Harris Fellow. Congratulations, George!



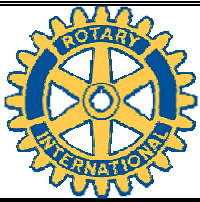

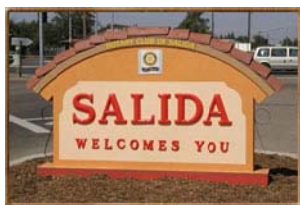
