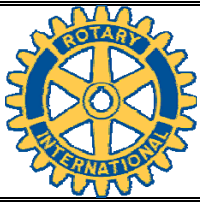
Loren introduced Chris Costin, our speaker.



Slovenia is getting ready to celebrate the 500th anniversary of the birth of Protestant priest Primož Trubar (1508-1586), who is considered the pioneer of the Slovenian language. The life and work of the author of the first printed books in Slovenian are to be celebrated throughout 2008 at a host of ceremonies, symposiums as well as through an extensive exhibition.

Chris Costin visited Slovenia with a performing group from his church. They performed in many different venues and sang in both English and in the Slovenian language. Part of their mission there was to support the teachings of Trubar, who broke off from the Catholic Church in the late 1500s. As a part of the departure, he began to develop the Slovenian language, which is still spoken today.
