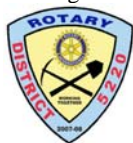

GREGORI HIGH UPDATE

Construction of Joseph A. Gregori High School has begun. Dana McGarry of Modesto City Schools reports that building pads have been completed, and installation of building footings is underway. Construction of utilities and storm drain lines is



also in process, as is the property line fencing. Dana is currently working on obtaining easement rights from local property owners along Stoddard and Perrone Roads, so that those roads can be expanded. Relocating MID poles must be accomplished before the roads are widened. Gregori High School is designed for 2,500 students. Current projections suggest it will reach 1,800 to 1,900 students. The majority of those students will come from Salida and Northwest Modesto. Gregori is scheduled to open in September 2010 with freshman and sophomore classes of students who are currently in the sixth and seventh grade. Dana suggests we drive by the school site to see the improvements under way.
