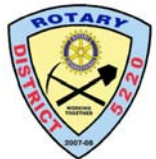



- Paul Sanders thought church was fun as a child and felt his calling while only 16 years old. He loves the ministry because he sees people’s lives transformed.
