George announced that the crab for the Crab Dinner will cost the same as last year – a nice surprise.

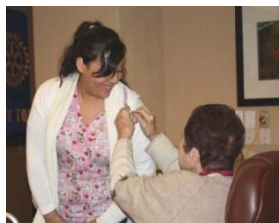
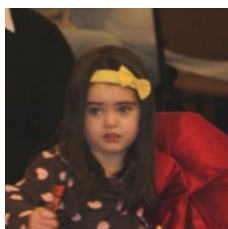

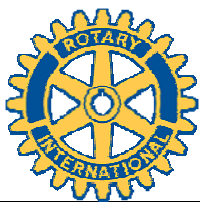
Dave Mantooth, of Escalon Sunrise Rotary, came to share his experience with a National Immunization Day in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.

In addition to humanitarian aid, the group also did some light touring and visited some Rotary projects. Much of what Dave showed us was new to most of us and quite unexpected, like castles in Ethiopia.

The entourage split up in to separate groups and each group was hosted by a different Rotary club. Each group served one village and surrounding area. While they did scheduled, centralized immunizations, they also went door to door, immunizing children in rural areas. The families were all very cooperative, mostly because the government supports the immunization efforts fully.

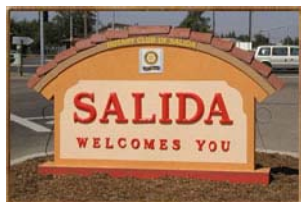
