Anne Klint – Rotary Ambassadorial Scholar

~by John Freeland - Rotary's Ambassadorial Scholarship Program is designed to further international understanding and friendly relations among peoples of different countries. Scholars are expected to be outstanding ambassadors of good will to the people of the host country through both informal and formal appearances before Rotary clubs and districts, school and civic organizations, and other forums. After study has been completed, scholars share their experiences with the people of their home countries and with the local Rotarians who sponsored their scholarship.



We were fortunate last week to hear Anne Klint describe her experiences as an ambassadorial scholar to Germany from District 5220. Anne studied art for ten months at the Fine Art Academy in Leipzig. Her medium is photography and new media and technology, such as video installation and projection. Leipzig is in the former East Germany, and its economy continues to lag behind that of former West Germany's. During her stay, Anne gave ten presentations, in the German language, to Rotary Clubs within a few hours train ride from Leipzig. She found that the larger, older Rotary Clubs in Germany are male only, and were unlikely to accept her invitation to speak. 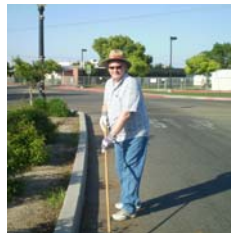
