Antarctica ~by John Freeland - June 12, 2009
Penguins abound in Antarctica, but their habitat is changing. Gradual ocean warming is causing increased melting of glacial ice on ocean waters. This is occurring primarily in West Antarctica. Ice extending from the shore provided a protection for sea life, particularly krill. Krill is the main diet for one species of penguins. With the retreating ice sheet, the protected habitat has been lost and the krill food supply thus diminished.

There is no disputing the phenomenon of retreating glaciers around the world. This can be visually confirmed by historical photographs. What is disputed is the cause of that retreat. The glaciers have expanded and retreated in cycles for millions of years. Scientists believe these cycles are influenced by the Earth's orbital shape, axial tilt, and axial, known as the Milankovitch Cycles. We are currently at the height of the cycle, and therefore experiencing a warmer period and thus smaller glaciers. The

rotation dispute arises between those who feel the Milankovitch Cycle is the sole cause of this phenomenon, versus those who believe the Milankovitch Cycle combined with man's industrial activity has increased carbon dioxide release, thus accelerating the greenhouse effect, causing further warmer of the Earth.

By analyzing ice cores, scientists have determined that carbon dioxide levels are higher than they have been in the last 650,000 years. Thus, the dispute is between those scientists who believe that increased carbon dioxide levels from man's activity has increased the greenhouse effect, thereby accelerating glacial retreat and global warming, versus those who believe the Earth is experiencing a naturally occurring phenomenon related solely to the Earth's distance from the sun, axial tilt and rotation.

Dr. Anderson didn't solve the dispute for us, but his presentation helped us to better understand the science supporting both sides.
